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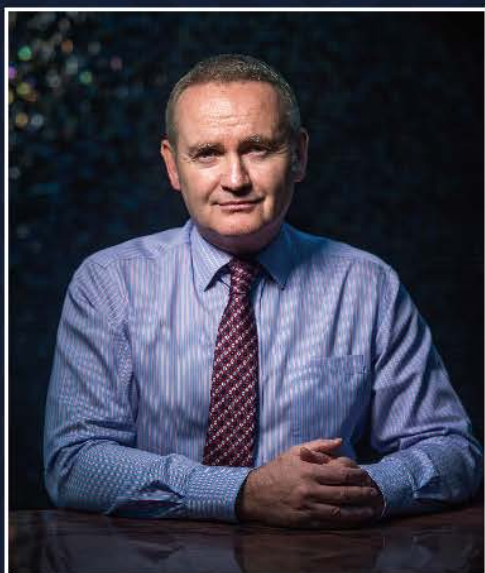

### Dear Students and Parents,

Since my arrival in July 2018 my family and I have enjoyed the warmth and friendship of the CAIS community and staff. We have all experienced a better year in 2020-21, with comparatively only a short reversion to online learning in Feb/March. Many of us are aware of others in situations less fortunate.

The school has continued to move forward on multiple fronts. We had a successful Pre-Evaluation visit by the joint **CIS/WASC Pre-Evaluation Accreditation** team in October, and have revised and updated all policies and procedures as required. These requirements included a definition of high quality learning at CAIS which defines what learning should look like for all our students. This is now on our website. We will send our updated report to CIS/WASC at the end of June.

As I mentioned in my initial message in 2019 we are truly an international mix with a cosmopolitan make-up. Although this year we were unable to replicate last year's highly successful **International Community Festival** we sincerely hope that we will be able to do so next year. Instead we created a new event for students led by Mr Damian, who helped create a hybrid House/International day experience for students *en lieu* of the International Community Festival.







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One of the key goals was to improve the holistic educational experience for CAIS students. From 2018-20 Secondary Mr Paul evolved the House from a one off Sports Day event, to involve a series of activities and events and sports throughout the year. The new Heads of House Mr Damian and Ms Rebecca have continued this. The Secondary Extra Curricula Activities program has been ably organized and led by Mr Kris who has ensured a broad range of activities, Arts and sports have been offered throughout the year, including our first ever Ski club and ski-trip led by Mr Stephen.

Parent workshops have continued to be successful and the simultaneous live translation to Chinese has clearly encouraged more parents to participate. We also moved **Parent Teacher Student Conferences** to Saturdays in response to feedback from the PTA regarding some parent work hours restricting the ability to attend during the week. These were online and in future when restrictions are eased we would like to offer parents the option of either a *face-to-face* or an *online* meeting option.

Every year we say our farewells to departing students and teachers as they move in to their next step. Thank you to everyone who has been a part of the CAIS community and we wish happiness and success to everyone who is moving on to their next step. We started recruitment in November and we are not only fully staffed for next year but have recruited a very strong team. The development here at CAIS has even attracted teachers from good schools elsewhere in China.

I will also take this opportunity to say my own personal farewell on behalf of my wife and children who have enjoyed three happy years here at CAIS. Thank you to everyone for your warmth, kindness and understanding. We would also like to wish you all safe travels in the summer and every success in whatever you are doing next year. I am confident that CAIS will continue and we will watch from afar the growth and development in the coming years.

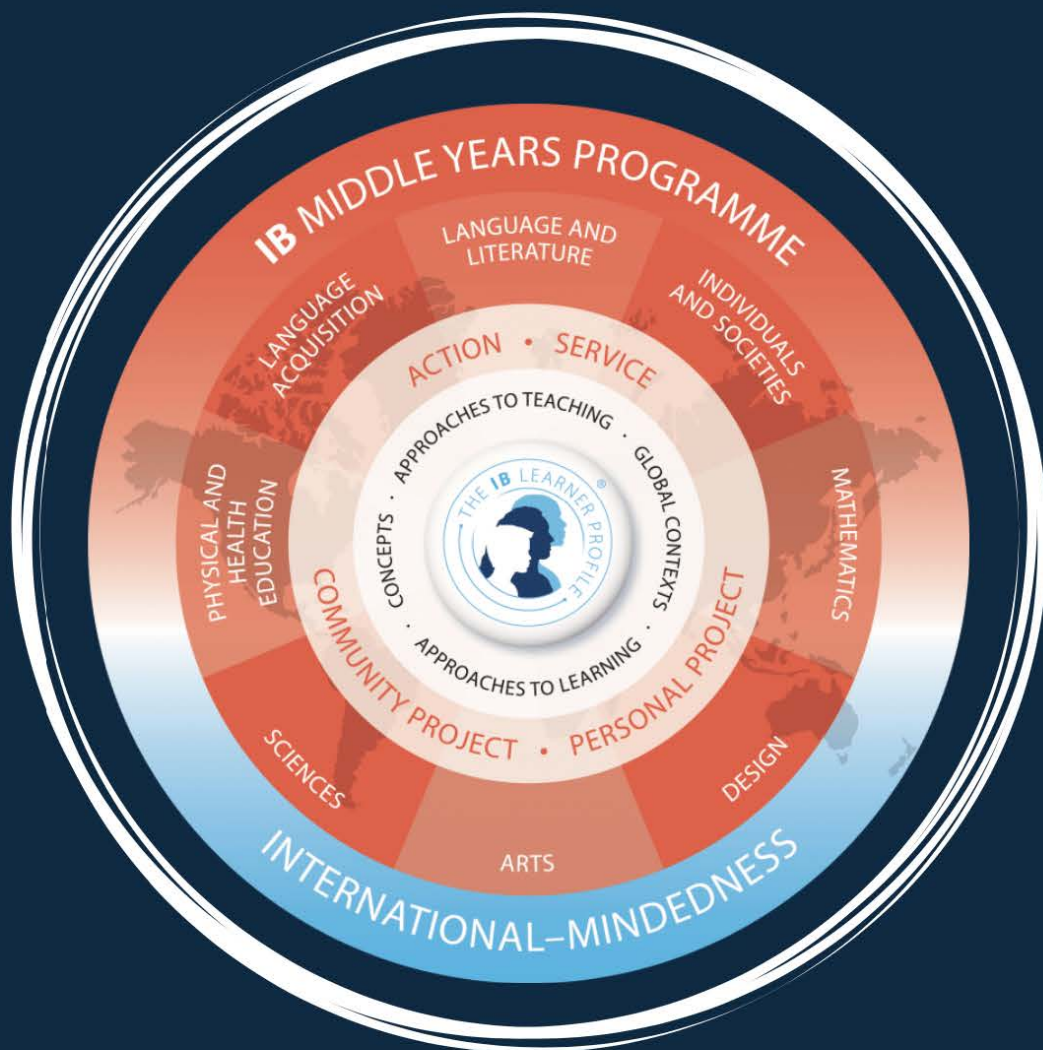
